- have a minimum amount of relevant work experience; and,
- then regularly renew certification by showing that they have met continuing ethical and accredited continuing education standards.

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The CIMA certification process

All CIMA candidates globally complete the same 5-step process. Typically, it takes nine months to a year to complete the program.

- Enrol In Australia and NZ, the Forum manages candidates through the process.
- **Apply** complete application (pay US\$600), undergo background check, disclose any potential or real violations of the Institute's Code of Professional Responsibility
- **3** Complete the IMAC successfully complete a local, specialist executive education program. In Australia and NZ, this is the blended Investment Management Analyst Course (IMAC), culminating in a four-hour exam. Delivered by CIMA Registered Education Provider, the Forum's Investment Management Research Program, in collaboration with Macquarie University Business School. Features a selected faculty of academics from leading Australian university business schools, independent consultants and experienced practitioners. **CIMA Society Associate member**
- **4** Complete the Certification Exam pass online, five-hour CIMA Certification Exam.
- Certify exhibit at least three years' relevant work experience, complete the licensing agreement, agree to the Code, pay Initial Certification Fee (US\$395). CIMA Society Certificant member, participate in the Forum, complete 40 hours of Continuing Education and renew certification every two years.



- Four-hours (240 minutes) via Zoom, proctored
- Closed book
- You can bring your financial calculator clear the memory before you begin
- You will have the formula sheet at the Exam
- Out of 240 marks
 - 60 multiple choice questions worth two marks each (50% of total mark)
 - 12 written answer questions worth 10 marks each (50% of total mark)
- Questions are based on the material covered in the IMAC that is, from all the online lectures, readings and tutorials
- Pass mark is 50%. Credit Pass (70%+) required to continue to the CIMA exam
- Opportunity to resit IMAC exam in December
- Opportunity to conclude study & become Associate Member, CIMA Society
